

ZONE C - Partial Reserve

Allowed:

- ▶ navigation by motor is permitted at a speed not exceeding 5 knots within a distance of 300 m from the coast and not exceeding 10 knots in the range between 300 and 600 m from the coast;
- ▶ mooring as prescribed by the Managing Authority; scuba diving according to the protection measures for the safeguard of the seabed;
- ▶ limited fishing for the professional fishermen of the communities whose coasts are included in the Reserve Area. The fishing equipment allowed must not damage the seabed and the quantity of daily allowed fish Load is dictated by the Managing Authority of the Marine Protected Area;
- ▶ recreational fishing, as long as these rules regarding fishing equipment and limits are followed:
 - a) from shore: up to 2 fishing lines and reel-equipped rods per person, with total hook length equal to or greater than 18 mm;
 - b) from vessel: up to 4 drift and fixed fishing lines per boat, with total hook length equal to or greater than 18 mm;
 - c) from vessel: up to 4 drift fishing lines with up to three hooks with a total length equal to or greater than 18 mm per boat and up to 4 cephalopod fishing rods per boat;
 - d) from vessel: up to 2 trolling fishing lines per boat, with total hook length equal to or greater than 18 mm.

Forbidden:

- ▶ trolling with a sinker and "monel" lines and guardian lead;
- ▶ fishing with the technique of vertical jigging and similar.

RULES AND GUIDELINES IN FORCE IN THE MPA

In the MPA all the allowed and forbidden activities are managed in detail by a definitive regulation (n. 299) issued by the Ministero dell'Ambiente e della Tutela del Territorio del Mare, with a decree dated 03/12/2014; it forbids the anchoring in the zones "B" and "C", except for sandy or pebbly seabed areas and purposely equipped and circumscribed areas. It's not allowed: underwater fishing, jet-skiing and all water sports with the use of dragging equipment.

RULES OF CONDUCT IN THE MARINE PROTECTED AREA

ZONE A - Full Reserve

Allowed:

- ▶ access to the staff of the Managing Authority of the Marine Protected Area for maintenance and control, and to scientific personnel for research purposes, after authorization;
- ▶ authorized guided scuba diving tours in restricted areas and only on approved routes.

Forbidden:

- ▶ swimming;
- ▶ professional and Sport fishing;
- ▶ boat cruising except for the patrol boats of the Marine Protected Area.

ZONE B - General Reserve

Allowed:

- ▶ navigation by motor is permitted at a speed not exceeding 5 knots within a distance of 300 m from the coast and not exceeding 10 knots in the range between 300 and 600 m from the coast;
- ▶ guided tours, including scuba diving, after authorization by the Managing Authority of the Marine Protected Area;
- ▶ swimming;
- ▶ mooring at suitable structures provided by the Managing Authority of the Marine Protected Area;
- ▶ artisanal fishing, restricted to professional fishermen residing in the municipalities whose coasts are comprised in the Marine Protected Area, if performed using selective fishing gear that must not damage the seabed and respecting the daily catch limits dictated by the Managing Authority of the Marine Protected Area.

Forbidden:

- ▶ professional fishing with trawl-nets;
- ▶ sport fishing of any kind and with any type of equipment.
